

Adult Games Committee Duties

State Spring Campout

This committee shall have charge of all adult games.

This includes:

- A. Selecting an assistant chairperson.
- B. Selecting a chairperson for each game to be held.
- C. Arranging for sufficient help to conduct the games.
- D. Spring games are those for which there is National Competition:
 - 1. Horseshoes: men's and women's singles and doubles, and mixed doubles.
 - 2. Volleyball: mixed team, maximum of (12) players.
 - 3. Washer Toss: men's and women's singles and doubles, and mixed doubles.
- E. Arranging to have the needed sports and other equipment on hand when needed. MSA owns some of the equipment; see the sports equipment handler for this. Some things will have to be obtained from members or locally. MSA equipment includes:
 - 1. Horseshoes.
 - 2. Volley ball.
 - 3. Washer toss boards and washers.
- F. Selecting playing areas that meet the requirements laid out in the guidelines for each game.
- G. Obtaining the required officials to officiate at the games.
- H. Obtaining the required awards.
- I. Scheduling the time of each game, in co-operation with the Program Booklet Committee.
- J. Random assigning playing order for each game.
- K. Registering each team or player.
- L. Handling all other details that it takes to run the games.
- M. Reporting committee expenses to the campout treasurer within fifteen (15) days in MSA format.
- N. Reporting committee activities to campout secretary within fifteen (15) days, in writing. This should include:
 - 1. The number of contestants in each game.
 - 2. The winners of each game.
 - 3. Other details that would be of interest to future adult games committee.
