## **Teen Committee Guidelines**

- 1. Appoint a teen dance committee...it would be helpful to include teens on the committee.
- 2. The teen dance committed shall obtain a DJ.
- 3. Teen activities are to end a 12:00 AM.
- 4. Teen curfew hours at 1:00 AM. All teens must be in their own area by that time unless accompanied by their parents or guardians. (Exception: if with chaperons on an approved teen project).
- 5. NO OPEN POP OR OTHER DRINK CONTAINERS SHALL BE BROUGHT INTO THE TEEN ACTIVITY AREAS.
- 6. Any sealed nonalcoholic drinks shall be allowed in the teen activity areas. If the opened beverage is removed from the activity area, it will not be permitted back in.
- 7. The chaperons and door checkers shall be adults, a few years removed from teens. Do NOT allow teens to assist with this duty.
- 8. The chaperons and door checkers shall be dressed equal to or better than the dress code, when one is in effect.
- 9. The chaperons and door checkers shall follow all teen rules while on duty. Therefore, no smoking, drinking of alcohol, etc.

10. The Fall dance committee, Coronation Ball, shall make sure that a copy of the Coronation

Dance Dress code is included in the mail-back packet and to be available for handout to drive-in registering families.

- 11. The entrance doors to the teen activities shall be controlled during open hours by door checkers who are to check for teen I.D. and to control the inflow of prohibited items.
- 12. A GOOD DJ is preferred.
- 13. The DJ shall meet the dress code during times of TEEN Dress Code at the Coronation Ball.
